KEY ISSUES DISCUSSED

- Acoustic impacts on neighbouring properties particularly from proposed basketball facility and justification for the proposed acoustic wall noting its proposed height of 2.4m.
- The Panel questioned whether there was a better location or better design that would result in a better acoustic and visual outcome noting the:
 - need for the acoustic wall (2.4m);
 - proposal to keep all windows and doors closed; and
 - need to provide mechanical ventilation to the basketball courts.
- Acoustic issues/ hours of operation of the dance hall.
- Traffic, parking, and amenity issues
- Need for further information/justification on the proposed carparking spaces including number of car
 parking spaces required for staff, and the justification for on-street parking noting the existing high
 demand for on-street parking
- Council does not have parking contributions plan applicable to this area
- The lack of vehicle service/emergency access to the Recreational building and Performing Arts Centre, where school and non-school events involving the general public were likely to occur, was seen as a significant omission which needs to be addressed
- Lack of information on identified Aboriginal items/relics and locations
- C4.6 variation to height of building (basketball courts) and the need for sound justification

- Visual impact of the basketball court building as viewed from the neighbouring properties on the eastern residential interface
- Justification to support the Applicant's request for an exemption from contributions (as a registered charity)
- Fire hydrants, access and fire management issues
- Cumulative impacts
