#### **MATTER DETERMINED**

PPSSTH-174 – Junee – DA2018/11.4 at 346 Old Sydney Road, Marinna – (Modification to) 30MG Solar Farm (as described in Schedule 1).

### PANEL CONSIDERATION AND DECISION

The Panel considered: the matters listed at item 6, the material listed at item 7 and the material presented at meetings and briefings listed at item 8 in Schedule 1.

# **Modification Application**

The Panel determined to approve the modification application pursuant to section 4.55 of the *Environmental Planning and Assessment Act 1979*.

The decision was unanimous.

### **REASONS FOR THE DECISION**

The Panel determined to approve the application for the reasons outlined in the Council Assessment Report subject to an amended condition of consent.

#### **CONDITION**

The Modification Application was approved subject to the conditions in the Council Assessment Report with an amendment to Condition 1(f) as recommended by Council, given the Panel was not satisfied that the proposal to modify the screening requirements to delete the need for screening along the northern and northeast boundaries had been fully justified. Justification for the removal of the screening requirement along these boundaries relied heavily on existing vegetation on public land that was beyond the control of the Applicant. The Panel was of the view that the retention and maintenance of this vegetation could not be relied upon over the life of the development. The Panel accepted the justification for the deletion of the requirement to screen the southern boundary. This is reflected in a revised Condition 1 (f) which reads as follows:

1 (f) The Visual Impact Assessment prepared by Accent Environmental dated 15 July 2022, with exception of Figure 5.2. "Onsite vegetation screening – Old Sydney Road Screening and R1 Option 1 (AE1207 Junee SF)" plan.

Landscape screening shall be provided in accordance with the Junee Shire Council annotated "Required Landscape Screening Location Plan" as attached and stamped with the approval.

All recommendations identified in the Visual Impact Assessment concerning screening, night lighting, glint and glare are required to be reflected in the site's final Operational Environmental Management Plan (OEMP).
