KEY ISSUES DISCUSSED

- RFS has recommended the creation of an APZ. A portion of the proposed APZ which will need to be provided on adjoining land owned by a third party
- BDAR has been provided and credits are required
- Deceleration lane is required and will result in clearing, excavation, and a sizeable retaining wall
- Pre lodgement process noting Council's concerns with lack of elevation plans and the need to adequately articulate built form
- Proposed built form including building arrangements and locations within the site, bulk and scale of proposed buildings and juxtaposition/proximity to adjoining residences.
- Council's concern re lack of justification for cl 4.6 request
- Relationships between the two proposed buildings having regard to their respective uses
- Integration of play areas within childcare facility
- Connectivity between group home and bus stop
- Car parking arrangements (noting use of mechanical car stacker)
- Natural light and amenity taking into consideration subterranean spaces and under crofts with little access to natural light
- BCA requirements for evacuation noting vulnerable demographic

- Contamination DSI completed
- 23 submissions received so a public meeting will need to be conducted
- Waiting on additional internal and external referrals

APPLICANT BRIEFING

Issues raised with Applicant during briefing:

- Justification for cl 4.6 request
- Retaining walls and deceleration lane and extent of cut to create the slip lane and loss of vegetation
- Subterranean connections between 2 proposed uses
- Offsite vegetation impact due to bush fire prone vegetation to the north of the site including the need to obtain landowners consent to create APZ
- Other referrals including environment (BDAR)
- Clarification of uses within site, including details around day program, and Link between the uses Day program is open to members of the units and also members of the public it is the same operator?
- Location of childcare centre relative to southern boundary
- Access and egress arrangements for emergencies
