KEY ISSUES DISCUSSED

Council Briefing:

Council assessment staff briefed the Panel and the following matters were discussed:

- Public consultation completed with three (3) submissions received raising issues regarding inadequate on-site parking provision, traffic issues during and after completion, flooding, and lack of a VMP.
- Flood hazard information and final building footprint.
- Concurrence and Referrals.
- Additional information requested from Council's Environment, Landscape and Traffic Officer's.
- GTAs for controlled activity issued by DPE Water which did not identify any concerns regarding the riparian corridor.
- RFI to be sent out once further internal comments received.
- Flood study, flood modelling, hydraulic analysis and the flood planning and evacuation key issue.
- S4.6 request relating to height.
- Landscaping, tree removal, and requirement for a VMP.

Planning Panels Secretariat

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• Traffic and parking implications and ongoing management.

Applicant Presentation:

- Overview of the proposal and site context and site constraints.
- Description of existing facilities and rationale for the proposed development.
- Overview of proposed design with access arrangements and pedestrian linkages.
- Design response to flood location and containment cell and evacuation and shelter in place arrangements for a flash flood event.
- Delivery, loading and unloading arrangements.
- Updated advice regarding tree retention.
- Funding dependencies, with construction scheduled to commence late 2024.

Panel Comments:

- The Panel noted that the Applicant's response to flooding and stormwater is currently being worked through by Council, and that all other issues appear to be resolvable.
- The Panel requested that a determination date be scheduled once the Applicant's response to Council's RFI had been received and subject to preliminary consideration.
