### **KEY ISSUES DISCUSSED**

Council assessment staff and the applicant briefed the Panel and provided details about the proposal and its assessment. Key issues discussed included:

- Nature of complaints received

- Refurbishment of maturation pads completed first week of November
- No proposed change to maximum volume of material processed
- No proposed change to number of Staff movements
- Material lifespan and process
- Whether extension of hours will be used to increase operating capacity
- The location of the dwelling with a deferred commencement approval (DA0171/2024 DA)
- Landfill diversion targets
- Council to attend meeting with EPA 18 December 2024
