When discussing the visual impact of the development, the panel noted the topography of the site, its location on the crest of a hill and the potential visual impact of the development from key locations in the broader area given the prominence of the site.

The panel indicated a more detailed assessment of the visual impact should be provided. The assessment should include the extent of the visual catchment, the scale, size and form of the project within the visual

catchment, representative viewpoints including key public locations, and the potential visual impact having regard to the scale of the proposal and the existing and desired future character of the area.
