# **Proposed Development**

- Demolition of existing structures including bowling green, relocation of existing playground
- Construction of a 'multi-purpose & evacuation centre' comprising of 2 x indoor multi court recreational facility/emergency evacuation centre and includes a storeroom, plant room, amenities, kitchen/kiosk, administration, meeting room, first aid room, waste room, off street parking and the provision of building identification sign
- Landscaping comprising 96 trees and 523 shrubs
