The Panel conducted an inspection of the site. Following the site inspection, the Panel were briefed by the Independent Assessment Planner appointed by Council. The applicant also attended the briefing to answer questions from the Panel. The following matters were discussed during the site inspection and briefing;

- Plan of management for the operation of the Indoor Recreation Centre
- Plan of management for use as an Evacuation Centre during emergency operations
- Proposed hours of construction

- Arrangements for ongoing maintenance of landscaping
- Maximum capacity of facility
- Clarification of capacity on which noise assessment was based (70 persons)
- Car parking provision and Council DCP requirements
- Traffic generation and car parking
- Arrangements for major sporting events
- Location of ventilation holes
- Location of batteries for solar storage
- Confirmation that reserve is an alcohol free zone
- Clarification of the classification of the development site and the broader reserve under the Crown Land Plan of Management
- Relocation of existing playground and bowling facilities
