KEY ISSUES DISCUSSED

The panel noted the applicant's presentation. The matters discussed with the applicant and council assessment planners during the briefing included:

- The background to the proposal, current operations, the proposed new extraction area, site history (low yield land) and location of sensitive residential receptors
- No additional infrastructure is proposed apart from an internal gravel road. Materials will be transported from the proposed extraction area to existing processing facilities (with existing infrastructure)
- There is to be no increase in yearly extraction.
- Most trees within the extraction area will be retained.
- An amendment to the operators existing EPA license has been sought
- The application is on public exhibition until 2 June 2025.
- Key issues thus far relate to dust and noise and potential impacts on sensitive receivers and the need to ensure contributions for road maintenance continue either through an updated VPA or 7.11 contributions
- Awaiting responses from EPA and WaterNSW

Next Steps

Planning Panels Team

- Council to issue RFI within 7 days
- Once Council receives all referrals and a response to the further information request, council to discuss with DPHI secretariat the need for a further briefing. If not necessary, the application should proceed to determination.
