KEY ISSUES DISCUSSED

- Noting the urgency of the Application, the Panel would like to see the application reported for determination at the earliest convenience for Council's assessment staff.
- Issues of car parking, bus parking, and equitable access within the building remain unresolved.
- Issues associated with the impact of construction works on the operation of the school, and the amenity for staff and students, should be examined carefully. Safety is critical and a safe work construction management plan which gives clarity for the separation of construction activities and the school's operation, and the impacts of construction, would be encouraged at DA stage.
- Noting that this is a new planned subdivision area, parking for the school should be better resolved.
- The Council suggested that the owner of adjoining land across Greenbridge Drive might be contacted to inquire as to whether dormant land could be utilised to reduce such impacts, at least during the construction period.
