PPSSWC-227 – Blue Mountains – x/38/2022 - 168 Hawkesbury Road, Springwood – a two storey classroom building and demolition of 8 demountable blocks and a sport court, removal of 12 trees, associated landscaping and stormwater works, and upgrades to existing roads

## **KEY ISSUES DISCUSSED**

- The primary issue discussed was the impact of the proposed new building on existing heritage items
  and their setting including canopy trees. In particular, the Panel is concerned to better understand the
  overall height of the proposed buildings in the context of the heritage items.
- Under consideration presently is whether the proposed development currently achieves an appropriate balance between heritage, bushfire and environmental matters, or could achieve an appropriate balance with modifications to the siting or design of the proposed building.
- A Clause 4.6 variation request to the Height of Buildings development standard under Blue Mountains LEP 2015 has been submitted, which will need to be carefully considered by the Panel.
- Council also noted that the adequacy of the Due Diligence Assessment in relation to Aboriginal
  Archaeology on the site, the adequacy of the revised conservation management plan and the adequacy
  of submitted landscaping and aboricultural information is being reviewed.
- Given that the site of Columbia's College and grounds is of very high heritage significance, the Panel will likely want to inspect the site prior to determination.
