ITEMS DISCUSSED

- Council summary:
 - o Proposal is under preliminary stages of assessment with an internal
 - Public exhibition is underway and due for conclusion on 31/03, Council does anticipate community interest.
 - Council is yet to undertake its full application assessment, so this record is not a final list of the issues they will need to consider in order to draft their recommendation.
- Applicant summary:
 - Overflow parking: there is no intention to have overflow parking to be allocated to the surrounding street network with the adoption of an existing online pre-booking system to control all parking demands and patron attendance at all service. The applicant submits the system promotes alternative methods of travel including car sharing and shuttle bus services.
- The application is yet to be considered by the Sydney Western City Planning Panel and therefore future comment will not be limited to the detail contained within.

KEY ISSUES IDENTIFIED FOR CONSIDERATION

- Compatibility of increased traffic movement and parking with the character of the site and immediate surrounds.
- Merit and legal consideration for the Panel to consider if the proposal is substantially the same form of development.
- Reference shall be made to Moto Projects (No. 2) Pty Ltd v North Sydney Council [1999] NSWLEC 280.
