PANEL CONSIDERATION AND DECISION

The panel considered: the matters listed at item 6, the material listed at item 7 and the material presented at briefings listed at item 8 in Schedule 1.

Development application

The panel determined to approve the development application pursuant to section 4.16 of the *Environmental Planning and Assessment Act 1979*.

The decision was unanimous.

REASONS FOR THE DECISION

The panel determined to approve the application for the reasons outlined in the council assessment report. In particular, the panel is satisfied that the application is consistent with the applicable planning controls and will have no significant adverse environmental impacts.

CONDITIONS

Contaminated land managed via an Asbestos Management Plan on the adjoining site to the north.

The panel considers that this concern has been adequately addressed in the assessment report and via an appropriate condition of consent.
