





#### SUMMARY OF APPROACH TO REVISED GOLF COURSE ROUTING

IN PLANNING THE 9 HOLE COURSE WE TRIED TO USE THE CORRIDORS OF THE EXISTING GOLF HOLES AS MUCH AS POSSIBLE. THIS WAS DONE IN ORDER TO CREATE THE LEAST DISTURBANCE TO THE EXISTING LANDSCAPE, AND ALSO BECAUSE MOST OF THESE CORRIDORS OFFERED GOOD OPPORTUNITY FOR FIRST-CLASS GOLF HOLES – IN SOME CASES WITH ADJUSTMENTS.

THE ADJUSTMENTS WERE MADE TO IMPROVE THE GOLFING ASPECTS OF SOME OF THE HOLES, BUT THEY WERE ALSO MADE TO IMPROVE THE SAFE INTERACTION BETWEEN HOLES FOR GOLFERS. ONE PRIMARY EXAMPLE OF THIS IS THE INTERACTION BETWEEN THE PROPOSED 5TH AND 6TH HOLES, WHERE THE 5TH GREEN HAS BEEN MOVED TO THE LEFT AND A POND PROPOSED ON THE RIGHT OF THE GREEN, BETWEEN IT AND THE 6TH TEE. THIS WILL IMPROVE THE SAFETY OF THE INTERACTION BETWEEN THE GREEN AND THE TEE.

WHILE THE AREA OF PROPOSED EARTHWORKS INVOLVING THE 5TH GREEN AND THE 6TH TEE APPEARS QUITE SUBSTANTIAL, THE PROPOSED WORK IS LOW LEVEL – AND INCLUDES THE POND – PARTLY TO ENSURE THAT THE FLOOD STORAGE AND FLOOD PASSAGE IN THE RIPARIAN ZONE ARE NOT ADVERSELY AFFECTED.

THE MOST NOTABLE EXCEPTION TO MAINTAINING THE EXISTING CORRIDORS IN THEIR EXACT LOCATION IS THE PROPOSED 3RD HOLE, WHICH HAS BEEN MOVED TO THE EAST CLOSER TO THE ROAD PARTLY TO IMPROVE THE SAFE INTERACTION WITH THE 2ND GREEN AND TO AVOID HITTING OVER THE RELOCATED 5TH GREEN. IT WAS ALSO PARTLY TO ALLOW A SENSIBLE GOLF HOLE WITH SUFFICIENT DISTANCE FROM THE PROPOSED 5TH HOLE.


THIS NEW LOCATION, HOWEVER, WILL MEAN CLEARING A SMALL WIDTH OF TREES ON THE EXISTING CREEK LINE TO ENABLE THE TEE SHOT TO BE PLAYED. ON THE OTHER HAND, WE HAVE ALLOWED TO PLANT SUBSTANTIALLY (BOTH TREES, SHRUBS, GRASSES, AND SEDGES WITHIN THE CREEK ITSELF) WHEREVER FEASIBLE IN THE 40 METRE RIPARIAN ZONE WHILE MAINTAINING A PLAYABLE GOLF COURSE. THOSE RIPARIAN PLANTINGS ARE INDICATED ON THE LANDSCAPE DRAWINGS, AS WELL AS THE PROPOSED REVEGETATION AND TREE PLANTINGS ELSEWHERE ON THE GOLF COURSE.


WE HAVE TRIED TO MINIMISE THE DISTURBANCE TO THE EXISTING LANDSCAPE ELSEWHERE, AND TO MINIMISE THE NUMBER OF LARGE TREES TO BE REMOVED. MANY OF THE TREES PROPOSED TO BE REMOVED ARE EXOTIC – PINE TREES IN PARTICULAR. WHERE EARTHWORKS ARE INDICATED ANYWHERE NEAR THE TREES TO BE RETAINED, WE WILL MAKE SURE DURING THE CONSTRUCTION PROCESS THAT THESE WORKS DO NOT AFFECT THE SENSITIVE AREAS REQUIRED TO MAINTAIN THE TREES. MOST OF THE EARTHWORKS PROPOSED ARE COSMETIC IN NATURE, AND NONE OF THEM COULD BE REASONABLY DESCRIBED AS 'BULK'. THE AIM IS TO PRODUCE NATURAL, ROLLING SHAPE AND TO MAKE IT FEEL LIKE IT FITS WITH THE EXISTING SHAPE OF THE GROUND. WHERE POSSIBLE WE HAVE TRIED TO BALANCE CUT AND FILL OPERATIONS OVER LOCALISED AREAS TO AVOID HAVING TO TRANSPORT MATERIAL OVER LARGE DISTANCES WITHIN THE SITE.

OUR DRAWINGS INDICATE FAIRWAY BOUNDARY LINES AND BOUNDARY LINES FOR 'SHORT ROUGH'. THESE MORE OR LESS OCCUPY THE AREA CURRENTLY GRASSED ON THE EXISTING COURSE, AND IT IS PROPOSED TO EFFECTIVELY IRRIGATE THE FAIRWAY AREAS SHOWN AND FOR THE SHORT ROUGHS TO RECEIVE OVERTHROW IRRIGATION. THESE LINES WOULD EVENTUALLY BE WORKED OUT IN MORE DETAIL ONCE SHAPING HAD BEEN DONE ON THE GROUND.

WE ARE VERY CONFIDENT THAT THE RESULT OF THIS PLANNING PROCESS WOULD YIELD A VERY GOOD 9 HOLE GOLF COURSE WITH REASONABLY MINIMAL IMPACT ON THE EXISTING LANDSCAPE, AND WITH EFFORTS TO IMPROVE THE LANDSCAPE, PARTICULARLY IN THE RIPARIAN ZONE. HAVING A VERY GOOD 9 HOLE GOLF COURSE IS IMPORTANT IN ORDER TO ENSURE THAT THE 'REDUCED' COURSE IS BOTH WORTHWHILE AND INTERESTING.

#### PHILOSOPHY AND DESIGN APPROACH

BOB HARRISON'S RECORD OVER THE LAST 30 YEARS DEMONSTRATES THE BELIEF THAT GOLF COURSES SHOULD LOOK AS NATURAL AND AS SPECTACULAR AS POSSIBLE. DURING A DISTINGUISHED CAREER AS A GOLF COURSE ARCHITECT, HARRISON HAS BEEN FORTUNATE TO WORK ON A DIVERSE VARIETY OF SITES. THESE RANGE FROM LAND THAT IS NATURALLY BEAUTIFUL SUCH AS THE WALLACIA COURSE, TO THOSE WHERE INTERESTING SHAPE AND LANDSCAPE HAD TO BE CREATED TO CREATE AN APPEALING GOLF COURSE. WE HAVE A LOT OF EXPERIENCE WITH GOLF COURSE PROJECTS IN LAND SIMILAR TO THE WALLACIA GOLF COURSE WHICH IS ROLLING CLAY COUNTRY, OFTEN ON A SHALE BASE. THESE PAST PROJECTS INCLUDE ELLERSTON, THE VINTAGE, STONECUTTERS RIDGE, RIVERSIDE OAKS, THE GRAND, AND BROOKWATER.

WE ARE INTERESTED IN THE ARTISTRY OF GOLF COURSES AND THE SHAPES AND DESIGN PATTERNS OF THE VARIOUS COMPONENTS OF A GOLF HOLE. THESE DESIGN IDEAS ARE SIMILAR TO THOSE OF ALISTER MACKENZIE. EVEN BEFORE THE IDEA BECAME FASHIONABLE, WE ALWAYS WORKED AT REDUCING THE COSTLY AND ENVIRONMENTALLY-DIFFICULT EXPANSE OF TURFGRASS TO THE MINIMUM THAT STILL ALLOWS GOLFERS TO ENJOY THE COURSE. THE CONTRAST BETWEEN MANICURED TURF AND THE SURROUNDING LANDSCAPE IS PART OF THE APPEAL OF EVERY HOLE, AS WELL AS BEING GOOD FOR THE ENVIRONMENT.

WE PAY GREAT ATTENTION TO THE STYLE AND PATTERNS OF SHAPE IN THE BUNKERING, BOTH AT THE GREEN SITES AND IN THE FAIRWAYS. WE WOULD MAKE EVERY EFFORT TO ENSURE THAT ALL OF THE SHAPING WAS ATTRACTIVE AND CONTINUOUS, SO THAT THE OVERALL APPEARANCE IS AS NATURAL AS POSSIBLE.


