 3.0 (12) Construction Management Plan - A construction management plan that includes, dust, soil and sediment and traffic management, prepared in accordance with Council's Engineering Design Specification, shall be provided to the PCA. The construction management plan submitted to the principal certifying authority should also cover risks associated with the potential interaction between students and construction activities, including vehicle movements.

#### CONSIDERATION OF COMMUNITY VIEWS

In coming to its decision, the panel notes that no written submissions were made during public exhibition and therefore no issues of concern were raised.
