### MATTER DETERMINED

PPSSWC-498 - Camden - DA/2024/552/1 - 100 Charles McIntosh Parkway, Cobbitty - Construction of a single storey, 127 place centre-based child care facility, a basement car park and associated site works. (as described in Schedule 1)

### PANEL CONSIDERATION AND DECISION

The panel considered: the matters listed at item 6, the material listed at item 7 and the material presented at briefings and the matters listed at item 8 in Schedule 1.

#### **Development application**

The panel determined to approve the development application pursuant to section 4.16 of the *Environmental Planning and Assessment Act 1979*.

The decision was unanimous.

### **REASONS FOR THE DECISION**

The panel determined to approve the application for the reasons outlined in the council assessment report.

In particular, the Panel concluded that:

- The development is consistent with the provisions of the applicable environmental planning instruments, including *State Environmental Planning Policy (Precincts Western Parkland City) 2021, State Environmental Planning Policy (Transport and Infrastructure) 2021, State Environmental Planning Policy (Resilience and Hazards) 2021, State Environmental Planning Policy (Industry and Employment) 2021, State Environmental Planning Policy (Sustainable Buildings) 2022* and *State Environmental Planning Policy (Biodiversity and Conservation) 2021*
- The development is consistent with the objectives of the Oran Park Development Control Plan 2007 and Camden Development Control Plan 2019
- The development complies with the relevant requirements in Chapter 3 of *State Environmental Planning Policy (Transport and Infrastructure) 2021* and the *Child Care Planning Guideline 2021*
- The development is of an appropriate scale and form for the site and the future character of the locality
- The impacts of the development are acceptable and can be suitably controlled under the recommended conditions
- The development will substantially increase the supply of child care places in an area which is growing rapidly, consistent with the strategic planning objectives for the area
- The development is in the public interest.

## CONDITIONS

The development application was approved subject to the conditions in the council assessment report.

# CONSIDERATION OF COMMUNITY VIEWS

In coming to its decision, the panel notes that no written submissions were made during public exhibition and therefore no issues of concern were raised.
