Review of Biodiversity Development Assessment Report (version dated 9/02/2021) for 99 Sargents Road, Ebenezer

Dear Natalie,

The purpose of this letter is to provide a review of the revised Biodiversity Development Assessment Report (Revised BDAR) prepared by Narla Environmental (Narla) for the proposed resource management facility at 99 Sargents Road, Ebenezer, New South Wales. A peer review of the original BDAR was undertaken in October 2021, which identified a non-compliances and made recommendations to update the BDAR. Narla subsequently prepared the Revised BDAR on 9 February 2021.

This review has found that the Revised BDAR adequately addresses the non-compliances and recommendations detailed within the first review. This includes the following matters:

- Refinement of PCT/vegetation zone boundaries;
- Consideration of alternative PCTs and justification of the absence of TEC vegetation;
- Clarification of changes to vegetation attribute data in management zones
- Further consideration of the occurrence of prescribed impacts;
- Further details of measures taken to avoid and minimise impacts; and
- Clarification and expansion of mitigation measures.

Any Conditions of Consent issued for the project should include the following:

- Commitments detailed within the Outcomes column of Table 12 of the Revised BDAR; and
- Requirement to satisfy the offset liability detailed within Table 15 of the Revised BDAR.
