PANEL CONSIDERATION AND DECISION

Development application

The panel determined to approve the development application pursuant to section 4.16 of the *Environmental Planning and Assessment Act 1979*.

The decision was unanimous.

REASONS FOR THE DECISION

The panel determined to approve the application for the reasons outlined in the council assessment report.

CONDITIONS

The development application was approved subject to the conditions in the council assessment report, with the addition of the following conditions:

- Condition 31 to ensure that all civil works approved under s138 of the Roads Act 1993 are
 completed prior to the issuing of an Occupation Certificate for the proposed development. This is
 to include line marking of the proposed angle parking in Brennan Street and the provision of an
 accessible parking space in Brennan Street.
- Condition 32 to ensure that the Plan of Management for the proposed facility is finalised and adopted prior to the issuing of an Occupation Certificate, with the Plan of Management being appropriately communicated to all stakeholders during the operation of the facility.

CONSIDERATION OF COMMUNITY VIEWS

In coming to its decision, the panel notes that no written submissions were made during public exhibition and therefore no issues of concern were raised.
