#### **MATTER DETERMINED**

PPSWES-115 – Griffith – DA244/2020 at 85-119 Merrigal Street Griffith for modifications and alterations (as described in Schedule 1)

### PANEL CONSIDERATION AND DECISION

The panel considered: the matters listed at item 6, the material listed at item 7 and the material presented at meetings and briefings listed at item 8 in Schedule 1.

# **Development application**

The panel determined to approve the modification to the development application pursuant to section 4.55(2) of the *Environmental Planning and Assessment Act 1979*.

The decision was unanimous.

#### **REASONS FOR THE DECISION**

The panel determined to approve the section 4.55(2) modification for the reasons outlined in the council assessment report. The panel also noted changes proposed to the configuration of the louvres and fenestration in the stadium's southern elevation. While these changes were not addressed in the assessment report, the panel felt they were acceptable and consistent with similar changes proposed and assessed for the stadium's western elevation.

### **CONDITIONS**

The section 4.55(2) application was approved subject to the conditions in the council assessment report.

# **CONSIDERATION OF COMMUNITY VIEWS**

In coming to its decision, the panel considered the one written submission made during public exhibition. The panel notes that issues of concern included:

• No inclusion of kerb & gutter from the Day St intersection right up to the proposed carpark entry.

• location of 10 informal 90 degree car spaces before the Day St & Merrigal St intersection approaching from Yarrabee St end.

The panel considers that concerns raised by the community have been adequately addressed in the assessment report.
