## Attachment G – General Terms of Approval – Heritage NSW

## Approved development

Development must be in accordance with:

- a. Aboriginal Cultural Heritage & Historic Heritage Assessment Report Western Riverina Quarry Expansion, Rankin Springs NSW (OzArk, 27 March 2024).
- b. Plan of Management Koomaringa Aboriginal Place Rankin Springs, NSW (OzArk, 27 March 2024), as amended from time to time and as endorsed by Heritage NSW.
- c. Environmental Impact Statement for Western Riverina Quarry (R.W. Corkery & Co. Pty Ltd, February 2022) as amended by the Aboriginal Cultural Heritage & Historic Heritage Assessment Report (OzArk, 27 March 2024) in relation to Aboriginal cultural heritage sites, maps and management measures.

Please note that any modification of the above development that will result in impacts to Aboriginal cultural heritage must be referred to Heritage NSW to determine whether changes to these general terms of approval are required.

## Except as amended by the following general terms of approval:

- 1. A s.90 <u>Aboriginal Heritage Impact Permit</u> for the proposed works must be sought and granted prior to the commencement of works.
- 2. The Aboriginal Heritage Impact Permit application must be accompanied by appropriate documentation and mapping as outlined in <u>Applying for an Aboriginal Heritage Impact Permit:</u> <u>Guide for applicants</u> (2011).
- 3. Consultation with the Aboriginal community undertaken as part of the Aboriginal Heritage Impact Permit application must be in accordance with the <u>Aboriginal cultural heritage</u> <u>consultation requirements for proponents 2010</u>.
- 4. The Aboriginal Heritage Impact Permit application must be completed with reference to the requirements of the <u>Guide to investigating</u>, assessing and reporting on Aboriginal cultural <u>heritage in NSW</u> (2011).
- The Aboriginal Heritage Impact Permit application must include complete records satisfying the requirements of the <u>Code of Practice for Archaeological Investigation of Aboriginal Objects in</u> <u>New South Wales</u> (2010).
- 6. Long term management of Aboriginal objects must be considered as part of the Aboriginal Heritage Impact Permit application.
- 7. Management strategies identified in the Aboriginal Cultural Heritage & Historic Heritage Assessment Report (OzArk, 27 March 2024) to protect, manage and enhance the values of the Koomaringa Aboriginal Place are to be employed.
- Work must be guided by the Plan of Management Koomaringa Aboriginal Place Rankin Springs, NSW (OzArk, 27 March 2024), and as amended.
- All Aboriginal sites outside of the proposed Aboriginal Heritage Impact Permit (AHIP) area identified at Figure 10-2 must not be harmed, such as sites 52-5-0021, 52-5-0027 and 52-5-0075, during rehabilitation, revegetation and any other works.
