The following information is provided for your assistance to ensure compliance with the *Environmental Planning & Assessment Act 1979, Environmental Planning & Assessment Regulation 2021*, or other relevant legislation and Council's policies. This information does not form part of the conditions of development consent pursuant to Section 4.16 of the Act.

Heritage NSW

Heritage NSW recommends that the AHIMS record for Koomaringa Aboriginal Place (42-5-0005) is included in the reporting at the time of the AHIP application.

Heritage NSW recommends that works including the proposed carpark, walking trail, seating, signage and any further fencing that is required is included in the AHIP application as these works are within an Aboriginal Place and will require approval under s90 of the *National Parks and Wildlife Act 1974*.

Heritage NSW note there are a number of proposed activities that will be undertaken outside of the Western Riverina Quarry footprint and proposed AHIP area as mapped in Figure 10-1 of the cultural heritage report. Heritage NSW support these activities in general however, they remind the proponent that they need to consider whether these activities, such as fencing, signage and ongoing rehabilitation/revegetation works will require an AHIP and/or whether the current AHIP area proposed requires adjusting.
