### **KEY ISSUES DISCUSSED**

- Reguest for information (RFI) issued on 6 September 2022.
- The site requires an irrigation licence to operate as a sand quarry and no specific details provided.
- Concerns with irrigation channel as the current flooding issue can impact on operation.
- Council contacted Fisheries NSW regarding fish in the creek and they indicated no concerns as the site is located more than 40m from the creek bank.
- Council will seek comments on impact on irrigation.
- TfNSW requested further information on road capacity and intersection upgrade.
- Proposal involves transferring materials through internal roads to neighbouring location to process.
- TfNSW's request for road and intersection upgrade will depend on the capacity and the frequency of truck usage of the road for each individual quarry.
- Panel requests a briefing from Council and the applicant for early December 2022 and expects the application is further advanced for determination.
