KEY ISSUES DISCUSSED

- The Stage 2 Contamination investigation is still in progress. The report is to be provided to Council by 24 April 2023.
- Various heritage issues raised by Council's Heritage Advisor are being addressed by the applicant and will be the subject of ongoing liaison between the applicant and Council's representatives.
- The applicant's representatives confirmed there will be no increase in staff numbers housed in the police station as a result of the proposed development.
- It was confirmed that the applicant is committed to undertake all works contained within the Updated Schedule of Conservation Works.
- The Aboriginal Cultural Heritage Study (Archaeological Objects Due Diligence Assessment) has been completed and was submitted to Council on 30 March 2023.
