# **MATTER DETERMINED**

PPSWES-168 - DA227/22 - Lithgow

## Lot 1 DP1268778 – 10 Col Drewe Drive Bowenfels NSW 2790

Staged subdivision of one (1) lot into forty-six (46) residential lots and one (1) residual lot, civil works, and associated infrastructure.

#### PANEL CONSIDERATION AND DECISION

The Panel considered: the matters listed at item 6, the material listed at item 7 and the material presented at meetings and briefings listed at item 8 in Schedule 1.

The Panel has been briefed on the application on 21 February 2023, 22 March 2023 and a site inspection carried out on 14 February 2023. The application came before the Panel on 30 January 2024 for determination however the Panel was advised that road works had commenced on part of the proposed subdivision, specifically Road A. The Panel was further advised at this meeting that an application had been approved by the Council on 8 November 2023 under Part 5 of the *Environmental Planning and Assessment 1979* for these works. The Panel deferred consideration of the application as the Part 5 approval was not fully addressed in the assessment report prepared by the Department for Council, notwithstanding that the Part 5 approval predated the preparation of the assessment report. It was also not clear to the Panel at this meeting how the Part 5 approval by the Council impacted on the development application.

The Panel met again on 5 March 2024 for the determination of the application. Additional information was provided to the Panel in response to the reasons for the deferral of the application on 30 January 2024, including details of the Part 5 approval.

Leaving the Panel to consider only part of the originally submitted application is not primal. In coming to the conclusion that development consent could be granted, the Panel acknowledges the existence of the Part 5 approval. However, the Panel needs to make it clear that the Part 5 process undertaken by the Council, including the application, assessment and conclusions, are not matters that the Panel addressed or reviewed in any way because this would be beyond the Panel's remit.

## **Development application**

The Panel determined to approve the development application pursuant to section 4.16 of the *Environmental Planning and Assessment Act 1979*.

The decision was unanimous.

## **REASONS FOR THE DECISION**

The Panel determined to approve the application for the reasons outlined in the Council Addendum Report.

## **CONDITIONS**

The Development Application was approved subject to the Amended Conditions of Consent submitted with Council Addendum Report, subject to minor changes to conditions 1 and 2 to reinforce the exclusion of part of the subdivision from this approval and to reinforce the tree protection requirements set out in condition 43.

## **CONSIDERATION OF COMMUNITY VIEWS**

In coming to its decision, the Panel noted no written submissions were made during public exhibition.
