## MATTER DETERMINED

PPSWES-228 – Carrathool – DA 2024/038 at Kidman Way, Hillston – solar farm (as described in Schedule 1).

## PANEL CONSIDERATION AND DECISION

The Panel considered: the matters listed at item 6, the material listed at item 7 and the material presented at meetings and briefings listed at item 8 in Schedule 1.

#### **Development application**

The Panel determined to approve the development application pursuant to section 4.16 of the *Environmental Planning and Assessment Act 1979*.

The decision was unanimous.

# **REASONS FOR THE DECISION**

The Panel determined to approve the application for the reasons outlined in the Council Assessment Report.

[Note: The Panel considered that the applicant's submitted site plans were barely adequate for the purpose of this DA, with the legend details being less than informative and not being clearly consistent with the details in the site plans. The Panel therefore requests that, with any future solar farm DAs, the applicant must submit plan details that are appropriately informative of the solar farm proposal. To this end, the Council should reject acceptance of solar farm DAs under section 39 of the EP&A Regulation should such details not form part of the submitted DA documentation.]

# CONDITIONS

The Development Application was approved subject to the conditions in the Council Assessment Report, with minor edits to draft Conditions 3, 10 and 57, together with the deletion of draft Condition 24 for the reason that screen landscaping was not considered necessary given the setting of the proposed solar farm.

# CONSIDERATION OF COMMUNITY VIEWS

In coming to its decision, the Panel notes that no written submissions were made during public exhibition and therefore no issues of concern were raised.
