MATTER DEFERRED

PPSSWES-26 – Carrathool – DA2020/017 at Kidman Way Hillston for a solar farm (as described in Schedule 1)

REASONS FOR DEFERRAL

The panel agreed to defer the determination of the DA to enable the Draft Conditions of Consent to be appropriately refined. This refinement is to be undertaken collaboratively between officers of the Department of Planning, Infrastructure & Environment and the Council within the next two weeks.

The Panel is favourably disposed to the granting of consent to the proposed development but requires the consent conditions to be drafted appropriately and in the form of a Deferred Commencement Consent under s4.16(3) of the EP&A Act. The Panel is also supportive of the Cl.4.6 variation request. The deferred commencement consent conditions will require adoption of the proposed Voluntary Planning Agreement and the submission of a landscape plan proposing appropriate screen planting within the site.

When the refined conditions have been received, the panel will determine the matter electronically.

The decision to defer the matter was unanimous.
