KEY MATTERS DISCUSSED

The Panel notes the applicant's presentation and matters discussed with the applicant and council during the briefing. In particular, the Panel notes:

- 23 submissions received
- Landscaping will be up to 6m in height to screen views from heritage items
- The applicant indicated that CASSA will often not provide comment on solar farms
- Re soil erosion, there will be gravel under the panels, fixed panels and sloping site.
- Council concerns include:
 - o visual impacts as part of site is highly elevated
 - o impact on adjoining heritage items
 - o loss of valuable agricultural land
- Panel issues include:
 - a landscaping plan is required and landscaping should obscure the security fence
 - further detail to be provided on construction noise impacts and amelioration measures for nearest receptors
 - visual impacts

Note:

Council is yet to undertake its full application assessment, and therefore future comment will not be limited to matters discussed at the preliminary briefing.
