MATTER DETERMINED

PPSWES-295 – Murray River – 10.2024.157.1 at 234 Milgate Road, Moama – Extractive Industry – Temporary increase in extraction volume of up to 80,000 tonnes per annum for a period of up to 24 months (as described in Schedule 1).

PANEL CONSIDERATION AND DECISION

The Panel considered: the matters listed at item 6, the material listed at item 7 and the material presented at meetings and briefings listed at item 8 in Schedule 1.

Development application

The Panel determined to approve the development application pursuant to section 4.16 of the *Environmental Planning and Assessment Act 1979*.

Council's recommended conditions of consent were amended by the Panel to include the following changes:

- Heading "Conditions which must be fulfilled on approval of this consent" shall be changed to "Conditions which must be fulfilled prior to commencement of operations."

In coming to its decision, the Panel notes that no written submissions were made during public exhibition and therefore no issues of concern were raised.
