### **KEY MATTERS DISCUSSED**

The Panel notes the applicant's presentation and matters discussed with the applicant and council during the briefing. In particular, the Panel notes:

- The reason for the proposal is to address inadequate electricity to supply the approved almond processing facility
- No submissions received during neighbour notification
- The proposal is ancillary to the main use
- TfNSW and RFS have no concerns
- Internal referrals are available
- RFI response re landscaping and stormwater expected to be provided to Council within 2 weeks
- Construction noise will be below that indicated on the existing approval, although the Panel has requested information on the nearest sensitive receptors
- Council is to take into account adequate access for construction traffic
- It should be confirmed whether the Aboriginal Assessment Report findings for the existing approved development are still applicable

#### Note:

Council is yet to undertake its full application assessment, and therefore future comment will not be limited to matters discussed at the preliminary briefing.
