#### **MATTER DETERMINED**

PPSWES-39 – Griffith – DA244/2020 at 85-119 Merrigal Street, Griffith – Recreation Facility (major) – Sports Precinct Redevelopment – Westend Oval (as described in Schedule 1)

#### PANEL CONSIDERATION AND DECISION

The panel considered: the matters listed at item 6, the material listed at item 7 and the material presented at meetings and briefings and the matters observed at site inspections listed at item 8 in Schedule 1.

### **Development application**

The panel determined to approve the development application pursuant to section 4.16 of the *Environmental Planning and Assessment Act 1979*.

The decision was unanimous.

## **REASONS FOR THE DECISION**

The panel determined to approve the application for the reasons outlined in the council assessment report.

### **CONDITIONS**

The development application was approved subject to the amended conditions provided by the Council's Kerry Rourke on 18 December 2020 at the Panel's request, as further amended as follows:

Condition 20 is to be amended to transfer the completion of public footpath works around the
perimeters of the site (in addition to those required by Condition 19) into Stage 1. This is required
in order to connect the on-street parking areas around the perimeters of the site that have been
relied upon to, in part, cater for the Stage 1 facility parking demands, to the facilities via formed
footpaths.

Condition 20 is to read:

#### 20. Additional Footpaths Stage 1

Stage 1 works are to include the construction of a 2.5 metre wide, shared concrete footpath around the remaining frontages of the site. The shared path is to be constructed along Merrigal Street, Merrowie Street and Yarrabee Street for the full frontage of the subject allotment, or as otherwise agreed by Council, and is to include appropriate infrastructure to ensure safe movements are available for pedestrians crossing the road. Detailed design drawings are to be submitted as part of Stage 1 construction and comply with Council's Engineering Guidelines – Subdivision and Development Standards and Council's Pedestrian and Bicycle Safety – May 2018.

# **CONSIDERATION OF COMMUNITY VIEWS**

In coming to its decision, the panel notes that no written submissions in objection were made during public exhibition and therefore no issues of concern were raised.
