MATTER DETERMINED

PPSWES-52 – Leeton – DA118/2020 at 114-118 Pine Avenue Leeton for the redevelopment of the Roxy Theatre as a new community facility (as described in Schedule 1)

PANEL CONSIDERATION AND DECISION

The panel considered: the matters listed at item 6, the material listed at item 7 and the material presented at meetings and briefings and the matters observed at site inspections listed at item 8 in Schedule 1.

Development application

The panel determined to approve the development application pursuant to section 4.16 of the *Environmental Planning and Assessment Act 1979*.

The decision was unanimous.

REASONS FOR THE DECISION

The panel determined to approve the application for the reasons outlined in the council assessment report.

In this regard the panel supports the assessments report's view that the proposed alterations and additions will not have any significant impacts on the front facades of the Roxy Theatre and Sharp's Building and agrees that the impact on the rear façades of both buildings will be satisfactory. Furthermore, the panel notes the support of well-regarded heritage consultants Stapleton Lucas and Partners for the proposed works to the interiors of both buildings.

Significantly, the panel notes the General Terms of Approval issued by the NSW Heritage Council for the project.

Finally, the panel commends Leeton Shire Council for its vision and wisdom in initiating and professionally progressing this outstanding community project. The manner by which the Council has engaged the community in planning and progressing this important heritage restoration and community project has been commendable.

CONDITIONS

The development application was approved subject to the conditions in the revised council assessment report dated 2 June 2021.

CONSIDERATION OF COMMUNITY VIEWS

In coming to its decision, the panel notes that no written submissions were made during public exhibition and therefore no issues of concern were raised.
