It is understood that the applicant is proposing the rezoning of land for urban development and conservation purposes.

The site of the proposal is located within a declared Mine Subsidence District and future development will require approval from Subsidence Advisory.

The lease holder advises that future mining is possible under the site. Extraction of coal can cause subsidence which may impact surface development.

Future subdivision and development may require further consultation with the title holder regarding mining impacts at the time of assessment. It should be noted that Subsidence Advisory is not responsible for granting mining approvals or for mine regulation in NSW.
