The decision was unanimous.

REASONS FOR THE DECISION

- 1. The proposal relies on a purported change of circumstances. The Panel did not find any material change of circumstances since the recent gazettal of the amended The Hills Local Environment Plan 2017 in December.
- 2. The Panel is aware of the extensive strategic planning effort and believes that the proposal is inconsistent with that new strategic plan for the Showgrounds Station precinct and its surrounds and its resulting instrument.
- 3. Conversely, the Panel believes that maintenance of the recently introduced planning controls provides certainty and is in the public interest.

4. The Panel does not believe that the strategic test has been satisfied because the scale of the development and proposed additional height is inconsistent with clearly enunciated urban design principles for the precinct and the surrounds.
