REASONS FOR THE DECISION

1. The Planning Proposal has some strategic merit because of its potential to provide additional housing and commercial space at the southern end of the Parramatta Central Business District and close to Harris Park train station, but the strategic merit of the scale of this proposed development has not been demonstrated.

- 2. The site-specific merit of the Planning Proposal at the density and scale proposed is not evident. The Panel believes that the proposed application is grossly out of scale with the existing and planned future character of the area and will not provide an effective transition from the CBD to the surrounding low-scale residential areas.
- 3. The Panel is not convinced that there is a current need for the scale of development that is being requested. A comprehensive strategic planning study of the Parramatta CBD is nearing completion and the Panel has been advised that the rezoning accompanying this study (i.e., the current Parramatta CBD Planning Proposal) will provide sufficient residential accommodation to satisfy demands for the foreseeable future.
