I also confirm receipt of the payment of \$5,000 as the initial assessment fee.

An initial examination of your application has been carried out. At this stage additional information is required to continue with the assessment. The following further information is therefore requested:

- 1. Proposed access/egress arrangements to and from the proposed house lots/dwelling sites.
- 2. Confirmation of the likely number of dwellings to be constructed within the proposed E4 Environmental Living Zone. This is required as the site area would appear to allow up to 29 allotments, whilst the Request for Pre-Gateway Review report indicates approximately 25 allotments and dwellings. Further, the report indicates that the development mix is likely to include single detached dwellings and possibly medium density housing.
- 3. Any information on known aboriginal heritage or aboriginal objects.

Please provide the necessary information within 21 days of the date of this letter.

Please note that your request for review cannot proceed until this additional information has been provided. If the additional information is not provided by the designated date the review request will not be progressed and will be returned to you.
