The RFS has reviewed the additional information and provides the following comments:

- The RFS is of the opinion that the response from the proponent does not adequately address the matters raised in our previous correspondence dated 10 November 2015.
- The APZs remain outside of the 'residentially developable' E4 zoning, and furthermore, it appears that the APZs shown on Figure 4 of the Constraints Report prepared by Ecological Australia are not reflective of the APZs required for future dwellings to construct to BAL 29 under AS39592009 (as identified in Table 2 of the aforementioned report). This may result in future dwellings having to construct to BAL 40 under AS39592009, or alternatively will result in future APZs being larger than shown or assessed under the current plan.

 The RFS reiterates its expectation that future subdivision of the site will provide adequate perimeter access roads as per our previous comments.

In conclusion, the RFS is not currently of the opinion that the proposal has demonstrated consistency with S117 (2) Direction 4.4 'Planning for Bushfire Protection' and reiterates the comments previously provided, dated 10 November 2015.
