Martha,

All we know is that the Planning proposal seeks to rezone approx. 3 ha of land as E4 Environmental Living Zone to accommodate potentially 25 'eco-style' dwellings. However the proponent is seeking a lot average of 1,000 square metres so for 2.9 hectares and this equate to 29 lots. The proponent also seeks provisions to permit both single dwellings and multi-dwelling housing on the resultant 29 lots.


The total area of the subject site is approximately 125,775m or 12.5 hectares. The area of the land to zoned E4 Environmental Living is approximately 2.9 hectares. The suggested clause above could potenti result in approximately 25 allotments and dwellings within the proposed E4 zoned area.

The diagrams from the PP and ecological/bushfire Assessment suggest that the APZ will be in the E4 and E2 Zone, with the majority in the E2 Zone.

The diagram below is an extract from the Ecological/Bushfire Assessment showing the yellow dotted line as the development are (E4 Zone) and the APZ as a band of yellow shading.

These are conceptual diagrams because the final layout, siting and design of buildings and APZ would be subject to separate assessment when the DA is lodged if the land is partly rezoned E4 Environmental Living Zone.

Further to recent email correspondence and in particular the meeting held on 16th May with yourself, Deanne Frankel and Allison Treweek, please find attached for your review an updated ecological and bushfire assessment in addition to a report on access arrangements to the site.

- The updated report by consultants Ecological Australia Pty Ltd has sought to respond to the Department's letter dated 18th December, 2015, which requested additional information on the bio-diversity assessment of the site. Further it has addressed specific matters as raised by other agency submissions in late 2015 and also in the meeting held May 2016, in particular those raised by Allison Treweek from the Office of Environment and Heritage concerning ecology and bushfire management.
- 2. Calibre Consulting was also engaged to complete a review of comments provided by Queanbeyan City Council (now Queanbeyan and Palerang Regional Council) relating to servicing of the Site, and identification of any related engineering issues for the provision of vehicular access to the Site. At the meeting between you/John Franklin (Ecological Australia) with DPE and OEH on Monday we agreed that you would advise us by today if you and your client wanted more time to amend the additional info provide by ecological. I am mindful that you probably had to discuss this with your client. I have discussed with Deanne Frankel and we have decided to give you until COB Friday to indicate if you wish to amend the document and the amount of time you need.

As indicated at the meeting we cannot guarantee that the additional information provided by Ecological will be accepted by DPE, Council, OEH or NSWRFS when we initiate further consultation process on the additional information, and then complete our assessment.

You will also recall that we indicated that although the additional information deals with biodiversity issues, bush fire protection and environmental zones, Council had also objected to the proposal on the basis of servicing issues, particularly vehicular access to the site and that you may wish to discuss this further with Council to determine if they are willing to consider other options for the development of the site. If for example they cannot agree on a suitable access to the site any discussion of other options will be off the table.
