The Panel is not satisfied that the strategic merit test is satisfied for three reasons. First, it is not evident to the Pane that any of the New England North West (NENW) RP 2036, the draft NENWRP 2041 or relevant local strategic plans support the proposal. Second, the Panel believes the proposal is inconsistent with Ministerial Directions relating to rezoning of flood prone land, particularly that containing a floodway (see Tamworth City Wide Flood Study 2019). Third, the need for rezoning to create more industrial and business land has not been established because substantial suitably zoned, vacant, serviced and flood free land is available in the locality.

With respect to site-specific merits, the Panel has not undertaken a full assessment but records its belief that the site is significantly constrained by flood risk and is concerned about the need to import substantial volumes of fill to mitigate this risk and questions the practicality of maintaining off-site mitigation measures in perpetuity.
