REASONS FOR THE DECISION	

The proponent failed to satisfy the Panel that a FSR 7:1 scheme achieved a better planning outcome as required by Ministerial Direction 1.5 Parramatta Road Corridor Urban Transformation Strategy. The Panel considered that the difference between a FSR of 5:1 and 7:1 would not be minor, and in any event, sufficient information was not available to the Panel to consider a 5:1 scheme.
