The majority Panel decision to proceed to Gateway was approved 3:2, with Ken Robinson and Kevin Alker concluding the proposal lacked site specific merit as outlined below.

REASONS FOR THE DECISION

The Panel met with the Department, Council officers and Proponent and discussed the proposal and its evolution over the last four years, the extensive consultation between Council Officers and the Proponent and the proposal's assessment by both Council and the Department.

The Panel unanimously determined the proposal has strategic merit based upon the analysis contained in the Department's Briefing Report and Council Officers' responses to the Proponent's amended submission.

In terms of site-specific merit, the majority of the Panel determined the proposal had met site-specific criteria as outlined in the Department's Briefing Report and Council Officers' responses to the Proponent's amended submission.

The majority of the Panel believe the proposal is suitable to proceed to Gateway Determination. In addition and as recommended by Council Officers, the North Sydney's Local Planning Panel and the Independent Design Review, the proposal should be accompanied by a revised site-specific DCP which

gives full consideration to the issues of height, storeys and further setback of the tower above the podium on the Pacific Highway to provide facade articulation and wind mitigation.

Panel members Ken Robinson and Kevin Alker disagreed with the majority decision on site-specific merit to the extent they believe the proposed height, scale and bulk would be to the detriment of the nearby heritage conservation area. This impact would not be able to be managed through the site-specific DCP process. It was also considered that the proposed development did not sufficiently acknowledge the transition between the North Sydney CBD and Crows Nest.
