Determination of application for a site compatibility certificate for 2-4 Hilda Close, Taree (Lots 8 and 9 DP 710524) – State Environmental Planning Policy (Housing for Seniors or People with a Disability) 2004

I refer to your application of 27 April 2018 for a site compatibility certificate under clause 25(1) of State Environmental Planning Policy (Housing for Seniors or People with a Disability) 2004 (Seniors Housing SEPP) in relation to 2-4 Hilda Close, Taree (Lots 8 and 9 DP 710524).

I, the Executive Director, Regions, as delegate of the Secretary, have determined the application under clause 25(4)(a) of the Seniors Housing SEPP by issuing a site compatibility certificate subject to satisfaction of certain requirements specified in the certificate (clause 25(7)). I have enclosed the site compatibility certificate.

In issuing the certificate, I have formed the view that the site is suitable for seniors housing due to its proximity to residential areas, Manning Hospital and the retail, commercial and recreational services in the Taree town centre. The proposed use is considered to be compatible with surrounding land uses and is capable of meeting the criteria in the Seniors Housing SEPP.

I note that MidCoast Council supports the issuing of a site compatibility certificate. I have included a requirement in the certificate for a detailed landscape plan to be submitted with the development application in response to Council's comments about a need for landscaping to address amenity and vegetation loss and manage bushfire hazards.

I have also included requirements for the final number of beds within the residential care facility to be determined through the assessment of the development

application, and for the provision of private transport for residents to access external facilities and services.
