Determination of application for a site compatibility certificate for part of Lot 10 DP 1088869, John Oxley Drive, Port Macquarie – State Environmental Planning Policy (Housing for Seniors or People with a Disability) 2004

I refer to your application of 12 November for a site compatibility certificate under clause 25(1) of State Environmental Planning Policy (Housing for Seniors or People with a Disability) 2004 (Seniors Housing SEPP) in relation to serviced self-care housing on part of Lot 10 DP 1088869, John Oxley Drive, Port Macquarie.


The Northern Regional Planning Panel has determined the application under clause 25(4)(a) of the Seniors Housing SEPP by not issuing a site compatibility certificate (SCC) for the following reasons:

- development of the site for more intensive purposes would be premature until Council finalises its masterplan process for the area to ensure development of the site is compatible and integrates appropriately with the longer-term strategic planning for the area.
- the scale and built form of the proposed development is out of character with the existing surrounding development; and
- the SCC application contains insufficient information supporting the suitability of the site regarding flooding, potential contamination and infrastructure issues.

Further, the Panel advises that the permissibility of the proposal on the land affected by the SEPP (Coastal Management) 2018 is not resolved.
