Determination of application for a site compatibility certificate for 677, 687 Canterbury Road and 48 Drummond Street, Belmore – State Environmental Planning Policy (Affordable Rental Housing) 2009

I refer to the application, submitted by Pacific Planning Pty Ltd, for a site compatibility certificate with a development concept for 174 residential apartments, of which 87 (50%) will be managed for affordable housing purposes, with ground-floor commercial spaces at 677, 687 Canterbury Road and 48 Drummond Street, Belmore under State Environmental Planning Policy (Affordable Rental Housing) 2009 (Affordable Rental Housing SEPP).

I, the Deputy Secretary, Greater Sydney, Place and Infrastructure, under clause 37(5) of the Affordable Rental Housing SEPP have determined not to issue a site compatibility certificate.

In determining the application, I have considered Council's comments and have found the merits of the application do not satisfy the requirements of the Affordable Rental Housing SEPP.
