As discussed this morning, the proposal will need to be lodged as a new proposal on the portal.

This will require you to upload the latest planning proposal and accompanying documentation. The accompanying documentation should include the items you submitted with the proposal in December, including the Traffic Impact Assessment, Social Impact Comment, Revised Indicative Scheme, Detailed Site Investigation Report, Urban Design Statement, KAA Solar Analysis and Solar Analysis supporting material. You do **not** need to provide all of the historical documentation.

I have spoken to Council and advised that they will be required to refuse the proposal which will send this back to DPE within the portal. This will proceed in the system as a rezoning review, however, as this step has already been completed, DPE will progress the PP on portal.
