Subject: Tempe South LATM study - deferred

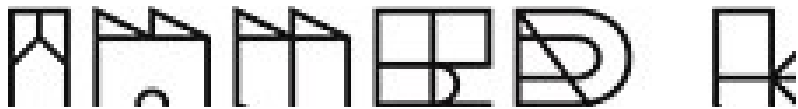
Hi Henry

Transport for NSW has called for a meeting between Council staff, councillors, Ministers Office, and TfNSW staff in attendance, to discuss the concerns regarding the proposed LATM study, traffic signals and the Bunnings site in Tempe. The face to face meeting was scheduled for 25 June 2021, however was deferred due to the recent Covid stay-at-home order. As there are direct implications from this meeting to the LATM study, the Traffic Committee would be unable to endorse the LATM study at its July meeting.

I have therefore been instructed to defer the final Tempe South LATM study report going to the Local Traffic Committee, pending the outcomes from this meeting. Understanding that this matter has been deferred in the past, we will make effort to get this report endorsed and adopted by Council at the next opportunity.
